ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, among others, orders have been issued for the functioning of Water Resources Department and Public Works Department as two separate departments.

2. In the Government Order second read above, order have been issued for dividing Public Works Department, Buildings Organization into 3 regions and on the works allotted to the Regional Chief Engineers.

3. In the Government Order third read above, among others, the subject relating to Water Resources Department has been allocated to the Hon'ble Minister for Water Resources and the subject relating to Public Works Department has been allocated to the Hon'ble Minister for Public Works.

4. In the Government Order fourth read above, amendments have been issued to the Tamil Nadu Government Business Rules, 1978 wherein the subjects relating to "Water Resources" which have been already existed under the heading "Public Works Department" have been omitted and those subjects have been inserted under the heading "Water Resources Department", separately.

5. In the Government Order fifth read above, orders have been issued for formation of a separate General Unit in the office of the Engineer-in-Chief (Buildings) and Chief Engineer (Buildings), Chennai Region, Public Works Department, Chepauk, Chennai to deal with all establishment matters of Public Works Department.

6. In the Government Order sixth read above, orders have been issued stipulating guidelines for the vertical separation of the Department into Public Works Department and Water Resources Department.

7. The Engineer-in-Chief (Buildings) & Chief Engineer (Buildings), Chennai Region, Public Works Department, Chennai in his letter seventh read above has requested orders of the Government on the following Amendments to the G.O. sixth read above :-

8. The Government after careful consideration, decided to accept the proposal of the Engineer-in-Chief (Building) and Chief Engineer (Building), Chennai Region, Public Works Department, Chennai and hereby issue the following amendments to the Government Order sixth read above :-

- (i) In the existing Paragraph 8, in SI.No.1 Chief Engineer Post, the Total Number under the item "Sanctioned Staff Strength as per change in ratio" shall be modified as **20** instead of **19**.
- (ii) In the existing Paragraph 8, in SI.No.2 Superintending Engineer Post, the Total Number in respect of Public Works Department under the item "Sanctioned Staff Strength as per change in ratio" shall be modified as **17** instead of **16** by adding one new post of Superintending Engineer which is created for a new Region at Coimbatore by re-organisation of Chennai and Tiruchirappalli Regions of Public Works Department.

After the above said Amendment the sanctioned strength as per change in ratio would be as follows:-

- (iii) In the existing Paragraph 9 (B) Ministerial Posts sanctioned to Chief Engineer (General) unit;
the following sub para shall be added;
- “The nomenclature of the **Engineer-in-Chief (Buildings) & Chief Engineer (Buildings), Chennai Region, Public Works Department, Chennai** shall be changed as “**Engineer-in-Chief, Chief Engineer (General) and Chief Engineer, Chennai Region, Public Works Department**”.
- (iv) In Paragraph 9 (F) for the existing sub para ;
- ‘The ministerial posts and administrative posts shall continue to function under the departments viz., Public Works Department and Water Resources Department, where they serve as on **06.06.2021** subject to the existing rules that are in force’
the following para shall be substituted;
- “The ministerial posts and administrative posts shall continue to function under the departments viz., Public Works Department and Water Resources Department, where they serve as on **01.11.2021** subject to the existing rules that are in force”.
- (v) In the Paragraph 9(H) Quality Control Divisions, the existing sentence in sub para viz., “Villupuram, Salem and Tirunelveli be relocated to **Chennai, Madurai and Coimbatore** respectively”
shall be substituted with the following sentence;
- “Villupuram, Salem and Tirunelveli be relocated to **Chennai, Coimbatore and Madurai** respectively”.
