Minutes of the 6th PEC Meeting held on 11.02.2021

The 6^{th} PEC meeting of AOE & AEA was held on 11.02.2021 at our Association office premises, chepauk, Chennai-5.

The meeting was presided by **Er.K.Prabakar**, President, AOE. The President welcomed all PEC members and requested them to actively took part in the Association. He also requested General Secretary, AOE to brief the PEC members about the subject agenda.

Er.M.Dhanasekaran, General Secretary, AEA telephonically informed that in view of this preoccupation with urgent work, he was unable to attend this meeting.

Er.K.Murugan, General Secretary, AOE explained the PEC members about the following subjects.

- 1) VII Pay Commission Present Stage.
- 2) Promotion & Court Cases in respect of 2007 batch Assistant Engineers.
- 3) Promotion panel of Executive Engineers, Superintending Engineers and Chief Engineers for the year 2020-21.
- 4) Annual Report & Accounts of our Association Presented for approval.
- 5) Any other subjects raised by members.

The PEC members expressed their views on the pending Court cases / Promotion Panels, implementation of VII pay commission pay scales to our Engineers and requested to take up effective steps to solve the above issues early.

The PEC members approved the Annual accounts of our Association and Poriyaalar Ramalingam Illam and it was decided to place the accounts in the next General Body meeting for approval.

The additional improvements done in the Poriyaalar Ramalingam Illam was also discussed and approved in the meeting. The issue of suspension of Chief Engineer, Superintending Engineer, Executive Engineer, Assistant Executive Engineer and Assistant Engineer in the failure of Enathirimangalam-Thalavanur Check dam in Chennai Region, WRO was discussed and it was decided to appeal to the Government to fairly analysis the causes of failure of Check dam and to revoke the suspension of Engineers which caused a negative impression about Public Works Department in the eye of Public.

The following resolutions were passed:

- 1. Resolved to pursue the Court case in the Pay Scale related cases and try to obtain favourable court orders.
- 2. Resolved to appeal to Assistant Engineers and Assistant Executive Engineer who had obtained stay in the promotion panels to come forward to accept temporary promotion so as to fill the vacancies in Assistant Executive Engineer and Executive Engineer panels for the time being until a final decision by the Government in this vexed issue.
- Resolved to appeal to Government to take all steps to give promotion to Assistant Engineers, Assistant Executive Engineers and Executive Engineers early.
- 4. Resolved to approve the annual accounts of our Association and Poriyaalar Ramalingam Illam and place them before the next General Body Meeting for approval.
- 5. Resolved to ratify the action taken for outer plastering one side of Poriyaalar Ramalingam Illam (exposed surface) Cost of Rs.1,65,000/ and purchase of 10 sets of Cot, Mattress & Pillow for Poriyaalar Ramalingam Illam Cost of Rs.1,36,360/-.
- Resolved to approve the appointment of **Thiru.P.Manikandan** as Room Boy in Poriyaalar Ramalingam Illam instead **Thiru.S.Venkatesan**, who resigned from the PRI.
- 7. Resolved to appeal to the Government to fairly analysis the causes of failure (including natural calamity) of Check dam at Enathirimangalam—Thalavanur, Chennai Region, WRO and revoke the suspension of Engineers (From Assistant Engineer to Chief Engineer) which causes much demoralization for our member Engineers.
- 8. Resolved to conduct next General Body meeting as a physical meeting at convenient time & date.

The meeting came to an end by about 8.00PM with vote of thanks by Er.A.Abdul Khudus, President, AEA.

Loans and Advances – House Building Advance – Migration of home loans taken by the Government servants from Banks / other Financial Institutions to House Building Advance – Guidelines and amendment to Rule 3 of "State Rules to Regulate the Grant of Advances to Government Servants for Building etc., of Houses" – Issued.

- G.O.(Ms.)No.24, Housing and Urban Development (HBA) Department, dated 02.02.2021

ORDER:-

The Government of India in Office Memorandum first read above, have issued conditions / clarification on migratin of interest bearing advances taken by the existing Government Employees for Home Loans from Banks / other Financial Institutions, based on the recommendation of the Seventh Central Pay Commission.

- 2. In the Government Order second read above, the Government have enhanced the ceiling of House Building Advance to All India Service Officers from Rs.40,00,000/- to Rs.60,00,000/- and to State Government Employees from Rs.25,00,000/- to Rs.40,00,000/- respectively for the following:-
 - (i) Partly for purchase of land and partly for construction of a house thereon, (or)
 - (ii) for the construction of a house, (or)
 - (iii) for purchase of a Ready Built House / Flat.
- 3. In this connection, there are repeated requests from the employees to allow them to migrate their loans availed from other financial institutions to the house building advance sanctioned by the Government.
- 4. The Government, after careful consideration of the above requests of the employees, have decided, in consonance with the order of Government of India in the Office Memorandum first read above, to allow the existing employees, who have already taken Home Loans from Banks and other financial institutions, to migrate to House Building Advance subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- a) Before granting such House Building Advance, the sanctioning Authorities,
- Should satisfy himself that the home loans were taken by the Government employee entirely for the purpose of construction / purchase of new house/flat.
- ii. Should ensure that the House Building Advance sanctioned is limited to the amount of loan still due to be repaid by the Government employee.
- b) House Building Advance can be availed towards repayment of bank loan taken for the purpose of construction / purchase of new house / flat.
- c) Employee shall be eligible for grant of House Building Advance as per these Rules, on the date he / she obtained loans from banks and other financial institutions irrespective of whether they applied for House Building Advance before raising the loan.
- d) House Building Advance for repayment of loans shall be granted to the eligible employees in one lump sum. However, the Government employee shall produce the House Building Advance Utilization Certificate within one month from the date of release of House Building Advance.
- e) Employee has to satisfy the other provisions of the "State Rules to Regulate the Grant of Advances to Government servants for Building Etc., of Houses".
- 5. The following amendment is issued to Rule 3 of "STATE RULES TO REGULATE THE GRANT OF ADVANCES TO GOVT SERVANTS FOR BUILDING ETC., OF HOUSES".

AMENDMENT

In the notes under Rule 3, the following may be added as (vi)

- (vi) The advance may also be sanctioned for migrating Home loan taken from Banks or other financial institutions, subject to fulfillment of following conditions:-
- a) Before granting such House Building Advance, the Head of the Department,
- I. Should satisfy himself that the home loans were taken by the Government employee entirely for purpose of construction / purchase of new house / flat.
- II. should ensure that House Building Advance sanctioned is limited to the amount of loan still due to be repaid by the Government employee.
- b) House Building Advance can be availed towards repayment of bank loan taken for the purpose of construction/purchase of new house/flat.
- c) Employee shall be eligible for grant of House Building Advance as per these Rules, on the date he/she obtained loans from banks and other

- financial institutions irrespective of whether they applied for House Building Advance before raising the loan.
- d) House Building Advance for repayment of loans shall be granted to the eligible employees in one lump sum. However, the Government employee shall produce the House Building Advance Utilization Certificate within one month from the date of release of House Building Advance.
- e) Employee has to satisfy the other provisions of these Rules.
- 6. All other conditions / orders in force shall be followed for sanction of the House Building Advance.
- 7. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.33/SS(PK)/2021, Finance (Hg.&UD.) Department, Dated 01.02.2021.

Fundamental Rules – Grant of Unearned leave on Medical Certificate – Amendments to 'Leave Procedure in the case of Government Servants' under Annexure II – Part – 1 of the Fundamental Rules – Orders – Issued.

ORDER:-

In the Government Order read above, consolidated instructions regarding the grant of Unearned Leave on Medical Certificate have been issued. In paragraphs 3 and 4 of the said order, it has been stated that these Instructions are to be included in the Tamil Nadu Leave Rules, 1933 by way of amendment to Rule 15 of the said rules and necessary amendments will be issued separately.

2. The Government have examined the above instructions for amending the Tamil Nadu Leave Rules, 1933. The instructions issued under paragraph 3(iii) of the Government order read above has already been placed under rule 71 of Fundamental Rules and placing the same rule again under Tamil Nadu Leave Rules, 1933 is not necessary. Further, the other instructions issued under paragraph 3 of the Government order read above are relating to Leave Procedures

and therefore it is decided to place them under the Rules made under rule 74 – 'Leave Procedure in the case of Government Servants' under Annexure II – Part-1, in Appendix-I, to the Fundamental Rules instead of amending rule 15 of the Tamil Nadu Leave Rules, 1933.

3. Accordingly, the following notification shall be published in **the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette:-**

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 read with Article 313 of the Constitution of India and of all other powers hereunto enabling, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Fundamental Rules.

2. The amendments hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 19th January, 2015.

AMENDMENTS

In the said Fundamental Rules, in Appendix I, in Annexure II-Part I, in the Rules under Fundamental Rule 74, under the heading "Leave Procedure in the case of Government Servants",-

- (1) after rule 3, the following rules shall be inserted, namely:-
- "3(A). Every application for leave on medical grounds or for extension of such leave should be sent to the competent authority within a period of seven days from the date of entering on or extending of such leave, along with the certificate issued by a Registered Medical Practitioner in the case of Group C and D Government Servants and by a Government Doctor or an Official Medical Attendant in the case of Group A and B Government servants.";
- (2) In rule 9A, after sub-rule (iii), the following sub-rule shall be inserted, namely:-
- "(iii-a) In cases falling under sub-rules (i), (ii) and (iii) above, the reference to the Medical Committee or the Gvernment Doctor shall be made within a period of three days from the date of receipt of leave application or extension therefor.";
 - (3) after rule 24, the following rule shall be inserted, namely:-
- "24A. The Government servant, who has not attended the Medical Board or Committee on the prescribed date or who does not join duty after obtaining fitness certificate from the Medical Board or the Committee, shall be proceeded against departmentally under the Tamil Nadu Civil Services (Discipline and Appeal) Rules for such lapses and on conclusion of the departmental action, the period in question shall be regulated as eligible leave other than leave on medical grounds except the period recommended by the Medical Board or the Committee, if any.".

ORDER:-

In the Government order read above, the Government had enhanced the ceiling of House Building Advance to All India Service Officers from Rs.25,00,000/- to Rs.40,00,000/- and to State Government Employees from Rs.15,00,000/- to Rs.25,00,000/- respectively for the following:-

- i. Partly for purchase of land and partly for construction of a house thereon, (or)
- ii. for the construction of a house, (or)
- iii. for purchase of a Ready Built House / Flat.
- 2. The ceiling on House Building Advance to the Government Servants was lastly revised in the year 2012. At this distance of time, considering that in the last 8 years the Schedule of Rate has doubled and cost inflation index has increased by 60%, the Government after careful examination have decided to enhance the existing maximum ceiling of House Building Advance.
- 3. The Government accordingly direct that the existing ceiling of the House Building Advance to All India Service Officers and State Government Servants be enhanced as follows:-
 - Partly for purchase of land and partly for construction of a house thereon, or for construction of a house or for purchase of Ready Built House / Flat from Rs.40,00,000/- to Rs.60,00,000/- (Rupees sixty lakh only) to All India Service Officers;
 - 2) Partly for purchase of land and partly for construction of a house thereon, or for construction of a house or for purchase of Ready Built House / Flat From Rs.25,00,000/- to Rs.40,00,000/- (Rupees forty lakh only) to Government Servants.

- 4. The enhanced ceiling of House Building Advance will come into force with effect from the date of issue of this order. Necessary amendment to the State Rules to regulate the grant of Advance to Government Servants for building etc., of houses will be issued separately.
- 5. It is also further ordered that the present ceiling of grant of House Building Advance not exceeding 75 months' Pay (Pay + Grade Pay + D.A. + Personal Pay) be enhanced to 90 months' Pay (Pay + Grade Pay + D.A. + Personal Pay), subject to the maximum ceiling.
 - 6. It is further clarified that,
 - I. Those who have been sanctioned House Building Advance at the old rate but not yet drawn any Instalment of the advance may also be sanctioned loan as per the new ceiling either for constructins / purchase of house / flat, if eligible, by issuing an amendment to the order already issued subject to eligibility.
 - II. All pending application for sanction of House Building Advance which have not yet been sanctioned for want of funds may be sanctioned as per the new ceiling limit now come into force.
 - III. Those who availed House Building Advance at the old rate and not completed the construction of the house may avail the difference amount in the enhanced ceiling for construction / ready built house / flat on production of revised estimate subject to eligibility.
 - IV. In respect of Government Servants, for enlargement / Improvement of existing living accommodation, the ceiling shall be 50% of the overall ceiling limit of Rs.40,00,000/-
 - V. As far as All India Service Officers are concerned, the Instructions already issued in G.O.Ms.No.419, Housing and Urban Development Department, dated 26.09.1996 shall also be followed.
- 7. All other conditions / orders in force shall be followed for sanction of the House Building Advance.
- 8. Separate orders will be issued by the Government in the Finance Department regarding the rate of interest applicable for House Building Advance for 2020-2021.
- 9. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.33/SS(PK)/2021, Finance (Hg&UD) Department, Dated 01.02.2021.

- 2. In his letter fourth read above, the Engineer-in-Chief, Water Resources Department and Chief Engineer (General), Public Works Department, Chennai has furnished the following points for consideration of the Government:
 - i. The delegation of powers of acceptance of tenders to the Chief Engineers / Tender Award Committee have been issued in the Government Order first read above 9 years back.
- ii. Subsequently, there was an increase in the value of estimates due to the manifold increase in construction cost inputs as well as increase in labour rates due to scarcity in availability of construction labourers for the past years.
- iii. The number of new public building projects / irrigation projects constructed and brought into use for the welfare of general public, the volume of works to be taken up and executed are increased every year in large numbers.
- iv. Further, every year, the increase in value of estimate due to the schedule of rates have to be accounted for in fixing the monetary limits on acceptance of tenders.
- 3. The Engineer-in-Chief, Water Resources Department and Chief Engineer (General), Public Works Department, Chennai has further stated that in view of the above the comparable & minimum increase in monetary limit on acceptance of tenders to the Chief Engineers of Water Resources Department / Building Organisation of PWD on par with powers already delegated to the Tender Award Committee have to be essentially required, considering the increase in construction cost inputs, as given below:-

 - v. In normal circumstances no revised administrative sanction should be sought and in exceptional cases where revised administrative sanction is sought, this shall be placed before the Tender Award Committee for its approval.
- 8. 
