Bifurcation of Sections opposed:

There is an ill advised move in the Water Resources Department in the form of discussion regarding bifurcation of Sections into Assistant Engineer Sections and Junior Engineer Sections under the guise of demand from the Government. A meeting to this effect was conducted by Engineer-in-Chief & Chief Engineer (General), WRD. We participated in the meeting and opposed the move citing our long pending demand of fixing B.E. Degree as minimum qualification for section level posts.

The above demand was sent to Government by the then Engineer-in-Chief, WRD and Chief Engineer (General), PWD, during 2007 itself and the same was not followed subsequently.

The challenge of section officer in PWD while in field or in office or in investigation project requires commanding knowledge of Technical Skills for which a minimum qualification as B.E. Degree is a must. Any change in the service rule must incorporate the latest situation / future demands of our Department.

Hope the Head of the Department will rise up to the occasion and save our rights.

Minutes of the AOE & AEA 5th PEC held on 13.07.2022

The 5th Combined PEC Meeting of AOE & AEA, TNPWD was held on 13.07.2022 (Wednesday) in the Association office premises by about 6.15 PM. Since **Er.R.Sornakumar**, President, AOE was pre-occupied, the meeting was chaired by **Er.K.Prabakar**, Vice President, AOE.

Er.K.Prabakar, President, AOE briefed the PEC members about the subject agenda and exhausted the members to be vigilant in protecting our rights. He invited the General Secretary, AOE to explain the subject agenda to the PEC members.

Er.K.Murugan, General Secretary, AOE explained the subject in the agenda in detail.

- 1) **Recruitment of Assistant Engineers in WRD & PWD – Present Stage.**
- 2) **Promotion Panels & Postings – Present Stage.**
- 3) **Pay Scale – Present Stage.**
- 4) **Approval of Accounts AOE, AEA, PRI, Legal Fund, ENGIBEF and Annual Report placing in the General Body.**
- 5) **Court Cases – Present Stage.**
- 6) **Improvements to PRI.**
- 7) **ENGIBEF V Phase – Present Stage.**
- 8) **Any other Subjects.**

All the PEC members present in the meeting actively took part in the deliberations and requested to pursue vigorously the following.

- (i) Continuation of our Pay Scale for newly promoted Assistant Engineers in the VI Pay Commission Pay Scales.
- (ii) To take steps to regularize the promotion of newly promoted Assistant Engineers by pursuing all the pending cases in High Court.
- (iii) To fill up Assistant Engineer posts in WRD & PWD by recruitment through TNPSC.

Er.M.Mathan, General Secretary, AEA explained to the PEC about the Court Case (which is heard on 13, 14 & 15th of July 2022 in High Court) regarding G.O.Ms.No.155 cases & cases related to recent temporary promotion given to Assistant Engineers.

Er.P.N.S.Mahesh Babu, Resident Engineer, Poriyaalar Ramalingam Illam explained the renovation works carried out in PRI and requested to permit of carrying out further maintenance works which are essential. He also informed that all the rooms will be provided with new cots and beds shortly.

Er.V.Ponraj, Treasurer, ENGIBEF requested to fix target for all branches to achieve a minimum of 1000 members with in a short time. So as to enhance the benefit to the deceased engineers family.

Thiru.S.Anvar and Thiru.R.Paramasivam our Association staff requested to increase in their salary (upto 10%) and the same was discussed in the PEC and it

was decided to approve an increase of 5% of their salaries from the month of July 2022.

The proposal of Engineer-in-Chief & Chief Engineer (General), WRD calling for meeting regarding bifurcation of Assistant Engineers and Junior Engineers section in PWD was discussed in detail and it was decided to oppose the same and request to fix B.E. degree as minimum qualification for section level posts.

After detailed discussion the following resolution were passed unanimously:

1. Resolved to pursue court cases regarding Pay Scale and obtain favourable orders for implementation of One Man Commission approved Pay Scales to our Assistant Engineers, Assistant Executive Engineers and Executive Engineers.
2. Resolved to request all the Executive Engineers, Superintending Engineers & Chief Engineers of PWD & WRD to fix the Pay Scales of newly promoted Assistant Executive Engineers as Rs.15600-39100+GP6600 and pursue with PAOs & Treasuries to pass the bills without any remarks.
3. Resolved to pursue the Court Cases regarding the promotion of Assistant Engineers appointed from Technical Assistants and other cases which are likely to be disposed in the High Court soon.
4. Appeal to the Government to approve Special Executive Engineer promotion for seniors in WRD without any further delay as promised in G.O.Ms.No.158, Public Works (D2) Department, dated 01.11.2021.
5. Resolved to thank **Hon'ble Minster for Public Works Thiru.A.V.Velu** for sanctioning one additional post of Special Secretary to Government, PWD in the cadre of Chief Engineer which will ensure the further growth of PWD.
6. Resolved to approve the accounts of our Association, PRI, ENGIBEF, Legal Fund and Annual report to be placed in the ensuing General Body Meeting at Erode on 30.07.2022.
7. Resolved to approve an increase 5% of salary from the month of July 2022 for our Association staff Thiru.R.Paramasivam and Thiru.S.Anvar.
8. Resolved to request all the branches to enroll more member in ENGIBEF in Phase V, so as to achieve the target of 1000 members at an early date.
9. Resolved to condemn the proposed move to bifurcate Section Level posts as Assistant Engineer Section & Junior Engineer Section in WRD and request our Engineer-in-Chief & Chief Engineer (General), WRD to fix B.E., Degree as minimum qualification at section level and any change in the service rule must be based on the present situation and according to the future needs of the department.

The meeting came to an end by about 7.30 PM with vote of thanks by **Er.A.Abdul Khudus**, President, AEA.

We wish to bring to the following or your kind information and urgent action.

Two Assistant Engineers of Tamil Nadu Water Resources Department **Er.R.Rajathilak & Er.M.Manimaran**, who are also members of our Association were brutally attacked on 08.05.2022 while performing their duty of eviction in encroachment along B-Canal in R.A.Puram area, Chennai, based on the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India Orders. One of our Assistant Engineer **Er.R.Rajathilak** was seriously injured and was in the ICU of Malar Hospital, Adyar and still not recovered fully. Even though huge Police Force was present at the site of eviction they are unable to prevent the attack on our Assistant Engineers. The Executive Engineer **A.Jayakumari** who was holding charge of Adyar Sub Division immediately complained to E4 Abiramapuram Police Station and FIR was issued by the Inspector of the above Police Station.

However we are disappointed that the culprits who had brutally attacked our Assistant Engineers are not yet arrested by the Police and the offenders are at large which may lead to similar instances in other areas also and cause hindrance of other eviction of encroachments by our Engineers in future.

We request you to kindly look into this matter and cause action to arrest the culprits who had brutally attacked our Assistant Engineers and they must be given punishment they deserve.

The Pay Scale of:

The cases are still not disposed in the Hon'ble High Court of Madras and the Stay Orders are continued. Accordingly our Assistant Engineers, Assistant Executive Engineers and Executive Engineers are continued to get their salary as per VI Pay Commission Pay Scales till date.

We have also given under taking to the effect that if any excess Pay paid consequent to the final disposal of the case will be recovered from the individual.

Many of our Assistant Engineers in PWD & WRD who are getting salary as per VI Pay Commission Pay Scale are recently promoted as Assistant Executive Engineers and the drawing officers have fixed their salary as per VI Pay Commission as Rs.15600-39100+GP6600 for which they are eligible as per Court Orders.

However it has been brought to our notice that some of PAOs / Treasury Officers are not admitting the above Pay Scale fixed for newly promoted Assistant Executive Engineers and returned their Pay bill with remarks.

We request that suitable instructions may be issued to the concerned PAOs / Treasury Officers to admit the Pay Bill of newly promoted Assistant Executive Engineers as per the Hon'ble High Court of Madras Court orders (Copies enclosed) until the disposal of the Court cases in this matter.

ORDER:-

The Government of India, Ministry of Jal Shakti, Department of Water Resources, River Development and Ganga Rejuvenation, in the letter first read above, has stated that Dam Safety Act, 2021 has been notified by the Central Government on 14.12.2021 and its provisions have come into force with effect from 30.12.2021. The Government of India has requested the Government of Tamil Nadu to constitute a State Committee on Dam Safety (SCDS) within a period of 180 days from the date of commencement of the Act and to establish in the Department dealing the Dam Safety, a separate organization, to be known as the State Dam Safety Organisation (SDSO), within a period of 180 days from the date of commencement of the Act.

2. In the letter 2nd read above, the Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department, Chennai has stated that, at present, there are 128 dams in Tamil Nadu. Out of 128 dams, there are 90 Water Resources Department dams (85 Irrigation dams including 4 Inter-state dams namely Mullai Periyar, Parambikulam, Thunacadavu and Peruvuripallam and 5 nos. of drinking water supply reservoirs) and 38 Nos. of dams under Tamil Nadu Generation and Distribution Corporation Ltd., (TANGEDCO). Dam Safety Operations are dealt by the Operation and Maintenance Wing of Water Resources Department headed by a Chief Engineer functioning with the following 3 Circles:-

- i) Dam Safety Directorate for Safety monitoring of all 128 dams in Tamil Nadu.
- ii) State Project Management Unit (SPMU) for Dam Rehabilitation and Improvement Project.
- iii) Workshop and Stores Circle for Hydro Mechanical Works.

3. The Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department, Chennai has also stated that the existing State Dam Safety Committee (SDSC) had been constituted to monitor the safety aspects of all the dams in the State.

4. The Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department, Chennai has also furnished the following details with reference to establishment of State Dam Safety Organisation (SDSO) and constitution of State Committee on Dam Safety (SCDS) :-

A. Establishment of State Dam Safety Organisation (SDSO)

- As per Section 14 (1) of the Act, the State Government has to form a State Dam Safety Organisation (SDSO) within a period of 180 days from the date of commencement of the Act. The Organisational Structure and work procedure of the State Dam Safety Organisation shall be prescribed by the State Government.
- In Tamil Nadu, State Dam Safety Organisation is functioning in the name of Dam Safety Directorate (DSD) under the head of Superintending Engineer and Director as a separate wing under the control of Chief Engineer, Operation and Maintenance.
- Dam Safety Act 2021, mandates that State Dam Safety Organisation (SDSO) shall be headed by an officer not below the rank of Chief Engineer, if the number of specified dams in the State exceeds 30.
- Also, as per section 15 of the Act, under State Dam Safety Organisation, officers and employees shall have such qualification and experience in the field of dam safety including Dam-Design, Hydro-mechanical Engineering, Hydrology, Geo-technical investigation, Instrumentation, Dam-Rehabilitation or such other field as may be prescribed by the State Government.
- Hence, new State Dam Safety Organisation has to be reconstituted with the total sanctioned staff strength and proposed staff strength as below:-.

B. Constitution of State Committee on Dam Safety (SCDS)

- Section 11 of the Act prescribes that the State Government has to constitute a State Committee on Dam Safety (SCDS) within a period of 180 days from the date of commencement of the Act, which has to be reconstituted for every 3 years thereafter. This committee shall meet twice in a year and one meeting shall be held before the onset of Monsoon.

- The State Committee on Dam Safety has to be reconstituted with the members as stated in the Act.

5. The Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department, Chennai and the Chief Engineer, Water Resources Department, Operation and Maintenance have furnished the following proposals to Government for sanction :-

A) Proposal for formation of new State Dam Safety Organisation (SDSO) with the following members:-

Annual consolidated reports of the Health Status Report (HSR) (Pre and Post monsoon) are also being prepared and submitted to Central Water Commission (CWC) every year.
- (b) Periodically carries out Phase-I Inspection of all 128 Tamil Nadu dams once in 5 years by the following 5 members committee headed by the Superintending Engineer, State Dam Safety Organisation and Inspection Reports for WRD dams are being sent to the Regional Chief Engineers, Superintending Engineers and concerned Executive Engineers.  - (d) Updation of National Register for Large Dams (NRLD).
 - (e) Conducting Meeting for Selection of Best Maintained Dam for every year.
 - (f) Scrutinization of Flood regulation / Water regulation rules prepared by the Dam Owners of each specified dam.
 - (g) Preparation of specified dam list and first comprehensive dam safety evaluation of each specified dam within 5 years from the date of commencement of this act.
 - (h) The State Dam Safety Organisation shall maintain a database for each specified dam recording all activities related to surveillance and inspection, all important events related to dam safety and with such details and in such form as may be specified by the National Dam Safety Authority and shall furnish all such information to the Authority as and when required by them.
 - (i) Before initial filling of the reservoir is taken up, the State Dam Safety Organisation shall inspect the specified dam either through its own engineers or by an independent panel of experts, who shall also examine the initial filling programme and prepare a detailed report thereof duly certifying the fitness of dam for filling.
 - (j) Monitoring of reports of Instrumentation of dams / Hydro-meteorological stations / Seismological stations installed at the dam site which are supervised by the dam owners.
 - (k) Rehabilitation of dams - make recommendations on the rehabilitation requirements of ageing dams; provide strategic supervision for such dam rehabilitation programmes that are executed in States through central or externally aided funding.
 - (l) The State Dam Safety Organisation of each State shall forward their Annual Report to the concerned State Disaster Management Authority and also make available such report in public domain.
- (2) Regarding the instructions to be given by the State Dam Safety Organisation to the dam owner for the safety of a dam, the State Dam Safety Organisation shall render its instructions to the owner of a specified dam on the safety or the remedial measures required to be taken based on the Phase-I inspection report and Health Status reports and also to ensure that remedial measures are to be carried out in time. Also, if any major issues or distress is found in the dam, the Chief Engineer and the Superintending Engineer, State Dam Safety Organisation along with the Phase I team will inspect the dam and give necessary remedial measures to solve the issues before the event of any failure of a dam.
 - (3) Regarding the preparation and Updation of Operation and Maintenance (O&M) Manual and Emergency Action Plan (EAP), the O & M Manual and EAP prepared by

the Dam Owners will be scrutinised in the State Dam Safety Organisation for furnishing the comments/observations and the finalized O&M Manuals and EAPs after incorporating the comments will be sent to Central Water Commission (CWC) for approval.

- (4) Regarding the Technical documentation of the dam / reservoir, the owner of the specified dam shall compile all technical documentations regarding its structure, hydrology, dam foundation, watershed upstream of dam, and nature or use of land downstream of dam along with information on all resources or facilities of economic, logistic or environmental importance which are likely to be affected due to dam failure and shall furnish all such information to the State Dam Safety Organisation and the National Dam Safety Authority as and when required by them. The documents prepared by the dam owners shall be reviewed by the State Dam Safety Organisation and finalised in the State Dam Safety Organisation.
- (5) The functions of the Dam Documentation Cell, Dam Designs and Hydrology Cell and Dam Hydro mechanical cell headed by the Executive Engineers are separately mentioned and clearly defined in the proposal for formation of new State Dam Safety Organisation.
- (6) The details which are to be submitted to the National Dam Safety Authority for review are given below:-
 - (i) The report of the event of any dam failure furnished by the dam owners shall be sent to the National Dam Safety Authority.
 - (ii) State Dam Safety Organisation shall maintain the records of major dam incidents of each specified dam, and furnish all such information to the National Dam Safety Authority.
 - (iii) Every State Dam Safety Organisation shall prepare Annual Report, within three months of the expiry of the preceding financial year, of its activities and safety status of specified dams in the State and such report shall be forwarded to the National Dam Safety Authority and State Government and that Government shall cause the same to be laid before each House of the State Legislature, where it consists of two Houses or where such Legislature consists of one House, before that House.
 - (iv) The National Dam Safety Authority, shall prepare a consolidated annual report of the dam safety activities of States in the country and submit the same to the Central Government within six months of the expiry of the preceding financial year and that the Government shall cause the same to be laid before each House of Parliament.
 - (v) State Dam Safety Organisation shall classify each dam as per vulnerability & hazard classification criteria as may be specified by the National Dam Safety Authority.
 - (vi) The National Dam Safety Authority and concerned State Dam Safety Organisation, in cases of specified dams being found to be distressed on account of their age, degeneration, degradation, structural or other impediments, shall suggest such remedial measures on such operational parameters (including

maximum reservoir level, maximum spillway discharge and maximum discharges through other outlets).

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Functions of State Committee on Dam Safety (SCDS) as per Act

1. For the purpose of maintaining standards of dam safety and prevention of dam failure related disasters, discharge such functions as may be necessary as per the guidelines standards and other directions issued by the National Dam Safety Authority.
2. To review the work done by the State Dam Safety Organisation
3. To establish priorities for investigations in case of specified dams under distress condition. In cases where investigations with respect to safety of any specified dam in the State had already been undertaken, to order further investigations in relation to safety of such specified dam and assign responsibilities for execution including the use of non- departmental resources, and association of independent experts where necessary.
4. Recommend the appropriate measures to be taken in relation to the safety of the specified dam which is under distress condition.
5. Establish priorities among projects requiring remedial safety works
6. To review the progress on measures recommended in relation to dam safety.
7. Assess potential implication of reservoir filling of a specified dam in the State on any upstream State, and coordinate mitigation measures with such Upstream States.
8. Assess potential implication of failure of a specified dam in the State on any downstream State, and coordinate mitigation measures with such Downstream States.

9. Assess probability of cascading dam failure, and coordinate mitigation measures with all concerned, including bordering States.
10. Recommend provision of funds for the purpose of planned and appropriately phased rehabilitation of ageing dams in the State.
11. Provide strategic supervision for such dam improvement and rehabilitation programmes that are executed through State funding.
12. Any other specific matter relating to dam safety which may be referred to it by the State Government.

6. The Government after careful examination have decided to accept the proposals of the Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department, Chennai and the Chief Engineer, Water Resources Department, Operation and Maintenance and hereby accord sanction to constitute the State Committee on Dam Safety and establish the State Dam Safety Organization, as detailed at para 5 above and to notify them in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette Extraordinary.

7. The Government also directs that, since already the dams are being supervised by Engineers of Water Resources Department only at Head Quarters, additional mandate shall be given to one of the existing Chief Engineers and other posts proposed shall be filled on redeployment or against surrender of the same cadre posts .

8. Accordingly, the notification for constitution of State Committee on Dam Safety and State Dam Safety Organisation, separately appended to this order shall be published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette Extraordinary.

9. The Works Manager, Government Central Press, Chennai-79 is directed to publish the notification in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette Extraordinary, dated 30.6.2022 and send 25 copies to Government in Water Resources Department.

10. This orders issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O.No.2427/FS/P/2022, Dated 22.6.2022.

In the Government Order first read above, the Government have issued orders for the stipulating guidelines for the vertical separation of Department into Public Works Department and Water Resources Department. Further, in Para 9 (H) of the above Government Order the Government have issued the following orders:-

7 Quality Control Divisions at Chennai (Taramani), Villupuram, Tiruchirappalli, Salem, Coimbatore (Pollachi), Madurai and Tirunelveli functioning under the control of Chief Engineer, Institute for Water Studies, Hydrology & Quality Control, catering to both Public Works Department and Water Resources Department.

Quality Control Divisions at Chennai (Taramani), Tiruchirappalli, Madurai and Coimbatore (Pollachi) shall be attached to Water Resources Department and Quality Control Divisions at Villupuram, Salem and Tirunelveli shall be attached to Public Works Department.

Since the majority of the works of Public Works Department are located in big cities such as Chennai, Madurai and Coimbatore, Divisions now at Villupuram, Salem and Tirunelveli be relocated to Chennai, Madurai and Coimbatore respectively and should be utilized by the Public Works Department and necessary infrastructure including building would be shifted/created.

2. In the Government Order second read above, the Government have issued orders for the following amendment to G.O.(Ms).No.158, Public Works (D2) Department, dated 01.11.2021. Further, in Para 8 of the above Government Order the Government have issued the following orders :-

In the Paragraph 9 (H) Quality Control Divisions, the existing sentence in sub para viz. "Villupuram, Salem and Tirunelveli be relocated to Chennai, Madurai and Coimbatore respectively"

shall be substituted with the following sentence;

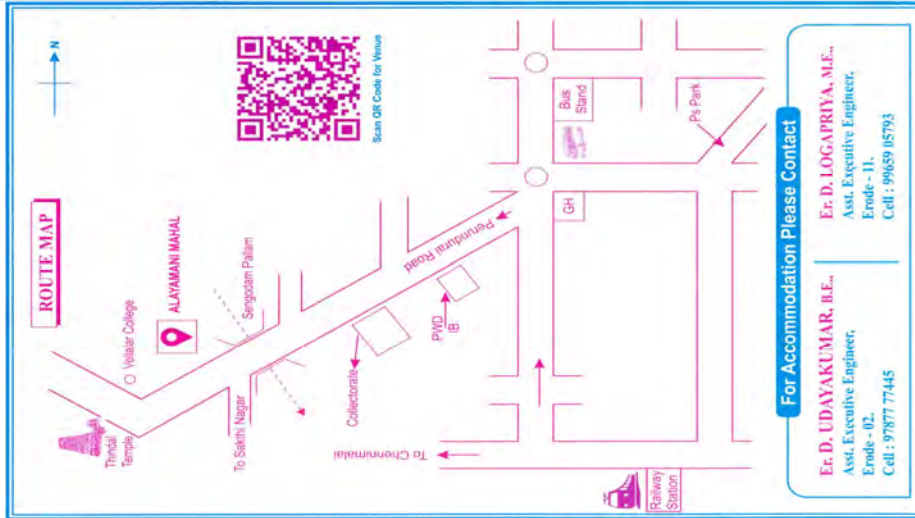
