Er.M.Dhanasekaran, General Secretary, AOE briefed about the subject agenda:

ORDER

In the Government Order first read above, guidelines have been issued for vertical separation of the Department into Public Works Department and Water Resources Department. In paragraph 9(C) of the said Government Order, among others, it has been ordered that all promotions / appointments from the year 2021-2022 has to be made by the respective Engineer-in-Chiefs of Public Works Department and Water Resources Department by formulating separate seniority list.

2. In the Government Order second read above, 10 numbers of Executive Engineers (Civil) were temporarily promoted under Section 47(1) of the Tamil Nadu Government Servant (Conditions of Service) Act, 2016 as Superintending Engineers (Civil) in Public Works Department. The last person promoted to the post of Superintending Engineer is Thiru.S. Thangarajan. Subsequently, in the Government orders 4th and 5th read above, 3 numbers of Superintending Engineers were temporarily promoted under Section 47(1) of the Tamil Nadu Government Servant (Conditions of Service) Act, 2016, as Chief Engineers in Public Works Department. The last person promoted to the post of Chief Engineer is Thiru. P.Mahavishnu.

3. Consequent on the promotion of junior Thiru. P. Mahavishnu as Chief Engineer in Public Works Department, the Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department, Chennai in his letters 7th read above, has requested orders of the Government to upgrade 8 numbers of Executive Engineer posts in Water Resources Department, who are seniors to those Engineers already promoted in Public Works Department, by prefixing "Special" to the upgraded post, as per paragraph 9(D) of G.O(Ms) No. 158, Public Works Department, dated 1.11.2021.

4. In paragraph 9(D) of the G.O first read above, the Government have ordered as follows:-

*"Paragraph 9(D): **Protection of service rights** of officials in all categories of posts governed by the State level one unit seniority shall be granted on the lines ordered in the G.O. first read above. Accordingly, if any junior official in any of the category of the Engineers who are covered under Common Seniority happens to get promoted either in Public Works Department or in Water Resources Department, the pay level of all persons senior to him/her shall be upgraded with monetary benefit with effect from the date on which his/her junior happens to be promoted by prefixing 'Special' to the upgraded post without any additional responsibilities. As and when the actual turn of the person so upgraded comes in the Department he/she serves, he/she may be accommodated in the promotional post and the post upgraded for him/her shall be downgraded to the pre-existing level".*

5. The Government after carefully examination accept the proposal of the Engineer-in-Chief & Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department and orders the following upgradation of posts

with monetary benefits from the date mentioned against them. This upgradation of posts involves no additional responsibilities of higher post:-

6. The Government also order that the upgradation of posts shall be subject to the following conditions:-

- (i). The above upgradation of posts at paragraph 5 to be treated as Supernumerary posts. The individuals who are upgraded should not claim any service benefits from the date of upgradation.
- (ii). The Special Superintending Engineer and Special Chief Engineer post so upgraded, shall be downgraded to the level of Executive Engineer with effect from the date of actual promotion to the post of Superintending Engineer and Chief Engineer in Water Resources Department, respectively.
- (iii). The incumbents of the supernumerary posts shall draw pay and allowances admissible to the post under the existing rules, including Dearness Allowance, House Rent Allowance, and other applicable benefits. The supernumerary posts are created by upgradation of existing posts to Level of the Pay Matrix, and the incumbents shall be entitled to pay fixation as per rules. Financial benefits, including arrears of pay and allowances, shall be admissible from the date of upgradation or as specifically ordered therein. The incumbents shall be entitled to increments and other service benefits applicable to the upgraded post, without affecting existing seniority. Creation of these supernumerary posts shall not adversely affect any financial or service benefits already enjoyed by the incumbents.
- (iv). There are no new posts created and the sanctioned strength remains unchanged. There is no requirement for additional establishment, infrastructure, office vehicles, or supporting staff. Therefore, there is no any additional administrative or structural obligations for the Government

ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, orders have been issued to constitute State Water Resources Management Agency (SWaRMA) with express provision for State budget funding and World Bank reimbursement during the project period, alongside explicit assurance of continued State funding after project closure. State Water Resources Management Agency (SWaRMA) was thus established as a continuing institutional component of Water Resources Department, not as a temporary, project-linked arrangement.

2. In the Government Order second read above, orders have been issued for further continuance for 43 Posts (Regular Posts-15 and Contract Posts-28) for the period from 01.06.2025 to 02.12.2025 and further continuance for 17 posts (Regular Posts-2 and Contract Posts-15) for the period from 01.06.2025 to 31.07.2025, with the enhanced consolidated pay/ contract pay, with an additional budget allocation of Rs.49,45,000/- (Rupees Forty Nine Lakh and Forty Five Thousand only) towards expenses of Salary and Other MDPU office operating cost under World Bank assisted TNIAMP.

3. In the letter third read above, the Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department, Chennai has stated as follows:-

- I. Exclusively to the continuance of the State Water Resources Management Agency (SWaRMA) as a permanent institutional entity under the Water Resources Department:
- II. Ongoing Technical Functions of State Water Resources Management Agency (SWaRMA):
 1. Basin-Level Data & Information Systems
 2. Hydrological & Reservoir Modelling
 3. Water Auditing & Irrigation Performance Assessment
 4. Command Area & Remote Sensing Studies
 5. Water Quality, Environmental & River Health Studies
 6. Tariff & Economic Analysis
- III. Way Forward – Proposed Technical Programme
 1. Basin Decision Support Systems (DSS)
 2. State Water Informatics Centre (SWIC)
 3. Advanced Flood & Reservoir Operations Framework
 4. Climate Resilience & Extreme Event Analysis
 5. Institutionalised Water Accounting & Auditing

Strengthening Requirements of SWaRMA:

To execute its full mandate efficiently, SWaRMA is proposed to be organised into four functional divisions:

1. Urban Water, Sewerage & River Health Division (Urbanisation – Pollution – Restoration)
 2. Basin Policy, Allocation & Water Governance Division (Policy – Planning – Regulation)
 3. Hydrology, Reservoir Operations & Flood Risk Division (Modelling – Safety – Resilience)
 4. Legal & e-Governance Division (Legal – e-Office)
- IV. The existing organisational structure of SWaRMA, as detailed in Annexure-I.
- V. The proposed organisational setup as detailed in Annexure-II.

4. The Engineer in Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department, Chennai has therefore requested to sanction the continuance of the State Water Resources Management Agency (SWaRMA) as a permanent State-level technical and governance entity under State funding, beyond the TN-IAMP project period, to safeguard institutional capacity and high-value decision-support systems, to revise four-division structure of State Water Resources Management Agency (SWaRMA) (Urban Water, Sewerage & River Health, Basin Policy, Allocation & Water Governance, Hydrology, Reservoir Operations & Flood

Risk and Legal & e-Governance) and to sanction the redeployment of 11 Water Resources Department personnel from MDPU to State Water Resources Management Agency (SWaRMA) on closure of MDPU, with full protection of service rights and without affecting sanctioned cadre strength, in accordance with norms.

5. The Government after careful examination have decided to accept the same and the continuance of the State Water Resources Management Agency (SWaRMA) as a one time extension of the 34 No. of posts from 03.12.2025 to 30.06.2026, as detailed in Annexure – I and II to this order.

6. The expenditure towards salaries and other allowances sanctioned at para 5 above shall be met out from the Head of Account 2701 80 001 AF 30000 in which sufficient provision is available.

7. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.7172/Finance (Infra.II) Department/2025, dated 12.03.2026.

ABSTRACT

Tamil Nadu Government Servants' Conduct Rules, 1973 – SimpleGov- Simplification of procedures for acquiring/disposing of vehicle by Government Servants – Intimation through IFHRMS – Instructions - Issued.

1. G.O.(Ms.) No.105, Human Resources Management (AR-1) Department, dated 28.11.2023.
2. Minutes of the SimpleGov- Empowered Committee meeting held on 09.02.2026.

ORDER :

In the Government order first read above, the SimpleGov initiative commenced with the formation of the Screening Committee and the Empowered Committee and the detailed process to be followed therein.

2. Sub-rule (2) of rule 7 of the Tamil Nadu Government Servants' Conduct Rules, 1973 prescribes that a Government servant who enters into any transaction concerning any movable property exceeding his total monthly emoluments in value, whether by way of purchase or sale, shall report to the prescribed authority within one month from the date of every such transaction.

3. Further, according to clause (a) of sub-rule (4) of rule 6 of the Tamil Nadu Government Servants' Conduct Rules, 1973 no Government servant shall, save in the ordinary course of business with a bank or a firm or a Public Limited Company of standing, duly authorised to conduct banking business either himself or through any member of his family or any other person acting on his behalf, lend or borrow money as principal or agent, to or from any person specified therein or lend money to any person at interest or in a manner whereby return in money or in kind is charged or paid and as per the proviso to said clause, the Government servant shall enter into such transaction with the previous sanction of the Government.

4. The SimpleGov proposal for simplification of procedures for acquiring/ disposing of vehicle by Government servants was compiled by the Advisor, SimpleGov, after due consultation with the Department concerned and placed before the Screening

Committee for its recommendation on 02.02.2026. The Screening Committee after due consideration has recommended to the Empowered Committee for its decision.

5. In the Empowered Committee meeting held on 09.02.2026, among others, the Committee perused and examined the recommendation of the Screening Committee on the possibilities for simplification of the process of acquiring/disposing of vehicle by Government servants and arrived at the following decisions:-

(a) Default digitisation: The existing paper-based process for reporting under rule 7(2) of the Tamil Nadu Government Servants' Conduct Rules, 1973 shall be fully digitised through IFHRMS platform.

(b) Mandatory entry in the Service record: All vehicle sanction and intimation records shall be automatically synchronized with the employee's digital service record maintained in IFHRMS portal.

(c) Self-declaration protocols for vehicle acquisition/disposal: A self-declaration mechanism shall be introduced for vehicle acquisitions funded entirely through personal savings or institutional loans.

(d) Clarification on borrowing under Rule 6(4)(a) of Tamil Nadu Government Servants' Conduct Rules,1973: Rule 6(4)(a) shall be clarified to state that loans sanctioned by banks, public financial institutions or registered non-banking financial companies for the purchase of motor vehicles shall not be treated as transactions requiring prior sanction or intimation.

6. Accordingly, the Government have examined the recommendation of the Empowered Committee regarding simplification of the process of acquiring/ disposing of vehicle by Government servants and has decided to issue the following instructions in this regard:-

(1) The Government servant shall submit an intimation regarding the transaction of acquiring/disposal of vehicle with the value exceeding three months total emoluments within one month from the date of such transaction under sub-rule (2) of rule 7 of the said Rule in the prescribed format along with the self-declaration as annexed to this order through IFHRMS portal. No permission shall be required for such transactions.

(2) All the transactions in respect of vehicle purchase or disposal shall be automatically synchronized with the employee's digital service book through IFHRMS portal with an acknowledgement.

(3) No prior permission is required under clause (a) of sub-rule (4) of rule 6 of the said Rule, for obtaining loans from bank, public financial institutions or registered non -banking financial companies exclusively for the purchase of vehicle.

7. Necessary amendments to Tamil Nadu Government Servants' Conduct Rules,1973 will be issued separately to this effect.
